

BY-LAWS OF  
ARMSTRONG-ENDERBY RIDING CLUB

MEMBERSHIP

1. All members interested in equitation and willing to co-operate in promoting the objects of the club are eligible to become members of the club.
2. The membership shall consist of:
  - a. Active members:
    - Senior
    - Junior – not to have reached 18<sup>th</sup> birthday as of January of the current year. (Amended April/86)
  - b. Associate members
3. Application for membership shall be received subject to the approval of the executive and upon payment of the current dues of an active or associate member, as the case may be. Junior members shall be required to produce proof of their age. (Amended April/86)
4. The amount of the annual membership dues for all or any or more categories may be changed by an ordinary resolution passed at any general meeting of the club. (Amended April/86)
5. The executive may post on the notice board of the club a list of all members of the club and all members whose annual membership dues for the current fiscal year have been paid shall be shown thereon as a member in good standing.

7. RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF MEMBERS
  - a. All members shall be entitled to receive notice of and attend all general meetings of the Club and to attend all social functions undertaken by the Club.
  - b. Senior active members shall be entitled to a vote, plus a spokesperson that shall represent the Junior membership. This representative shall have no vote but shall express the views of the body he represents. (Amended April/86)
8. MEMBERSHIP OBLIGATION
  - a. All members shall conduct themselves in a decorous manner and shall not by their conduct bring the club into disrepute.
  - b. Members shall be responsible at all times for the conduct of their mounts and shall accord them treatment that will be beyond fair criticism, either by the public generally or by their owner. The Executive shall deal with complaints of this nature.
  - c. Members shall observe and abide by the Constitution and By-Laws of the Club and all regulation lawfully made by the Executive.
  - d. Members shall observe and abide by all civic By-Laws and Provincial laws with respect to traffic and public property and safety.
