

CONSTITUTION OF
ARMSTRONG-ENDERBY RIDING CLUB

1. The name of the Society is ARMSTRONG ENDERBY RIDING CLUB.
2. The objects of the Society are:
 - a. To foster interest in equitation.
 - b. To bring together equestrian for mutual enjoyment of and to further the knowledge of horsemanship.
 - c. To organize, promote and manage appropriate affairs such as gymkhanas, horse shows, rides, lectures, demonstrations and other affairs, which may be decided upon.
 - d. To encourage participation and co-operation with other similar organizations.
 - e. To instill in the younger members the interest and responsibility required in the care and the use of horses.
 - f. To offer to all non-riding members an opportunity to join with riding members in all social activities of the society.
 - g. To rent, lease or purchase any land, buildings or equipment necessary to provide permanent headquarters and grounds for the aforementioned activities of the society.
3. The society will not operate as a Social Club and this provision is unalterable.
4. The operations of the club are to be carried on chiefly in the Armstrong-Enderby District.
